- The 2018 DOP Scholarship in the amount of up to \$2000 will be awarded to the most deserving applicant based on demonstrated outstanding academic achievement.
- Only applicants with strong academic credentials, including a minimum GPA of 3.5, will be considered.
- Special consideration will be given to applicants that demonstrate leadership and involvement in extra-curricular activities.
- Special consideration will be given to applicants who are or have a family member active in the AHEPA family.
- Special consideration will be given to applicants who learn and promote the Hellenic culture by learning the Greek language, Greek dances and participate in the church's Greek school and its activities.

The applicant must be:

A high school student in current graduating class accepted by an accredited college or University and scheduled to start full time during the current calendar year.

-- or --

A high school graduate who has been accepted by an accredited college or university to start full time during the current calendar year.

In addition, the applicant must be a member in good standing in our Church Community.

Deadline for submitting application:

All applications must be received by **3:00pm on Thursday, April 19.**

The Scholarship will be awarded on Graduation Sunday, on
May 20, 2018 following the Divine Liturgy

2018 DOP SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS- Page I

1. SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The Daughters of Penelope Alpheus Chapter #180 in Memphis, TN was established to promote, encourage, induce and advance education at the college, university, and professional school level.

2. ELIGIBILITY

In order to apply and be eligible for the scholarship, the applicant must be a member in good standing in our Church Community and belong to one of the following categories:

2.1. A student in the graduating class of his or her high school and planning to attend full time an accredited college or university during the current calendar year.

2.2. A high school graduate planning to attend full time an accredited college or university during the calendar year.

3. REVIEW CRITERIA

- Applicants must demonstrate strong academic credentials and achievements, to include a minimum GPA of 3.5, and involvement in extra-curricular activities.
- Special consideration will be given to achievements in music, athletics, or other pertinent areas, to demonstrated participation and leadership in student organizations and projects and community service.
- Special consideration will be given to applicants who are or have a family member active in the AHEPA family.
- Special consideration will be given to applicants who learn and promote the Hellenic culture by learning the Greek language, Greek dances and participate in the church's Greek school and its activities.

4. CREDENTIALS

4.1. TRANSCRIPT REQUIREMENTS

4.1.1. High school seniors must submit the most recent transcript as well as SAT or ACT scores.

4.1.2 High school graduates must submit the most recent transcript as well as SAT or ACT scores.

4.1.3. All transcripts must be official and sent **CERTIFIED RECEIPT** from the school directly to:

4.2. Applicants must provide the name of the College or University to which they have been accepted..

4.3. All applicants must submit an **ESSAY**, typewritten and **NOT TO EXCEED 500 WORDS** describing how the applicant has exhibited the ideals of DOP (Hellenism, Education, Philanthropy, Civic Responsibility, Family and Individual Excellence) OR why these ideals continue to be of critical importance today. The applicant does not need to focus on the entire list, and may choose to focus on any single ideal. The applicant's ability to organize and relate facts and ideas, grammar, and overall writing skills will also be assessed from the essay.

4.4. All applicants must submit documents supporting all honors (academic and non-academic), achievements, activities, Dean's List, honor societies, and employment while attending school or such claims will not be considered.

4.5. All applicants must include a letter of recommendation from one of the applicant's teachers, counselors or professors and one letter of recommendation from a responsible community (non-school) person. Both references should not be related to the applicant.

5. FILING

The applicant is responsible for the submission of all documents and completion of all sections of this application and mailing of this application. No items will be returned. **Applications not received by 3:00pm on Thursday, April 19, 2018 will not be considered.**
